More Research Projects should be funded

- MOUs should be signed with prestigious institutes and R&D Institutions of India
- Thrust area of research should be identified in each department and this activity be supported financially
- Full financial support should be provided to faculty members for participation in Conference and Workshops. Encourage faculty to go to reputed institution on deputation (with salary) for Research. A bond may be taken if necessary
- Seed money should be provided to all the faculty members for research activities
- More specialized English teachers should be recruited
- More professors need to be recruited in each department
- More computer literacy and English speaking course should be organized for staff Members.
- Imprest money should be provided to HODs and faculty members
- Create awareness on promotion policy for faculty and staff
- Cultivate a sense of belonging among all
- Support to students from humble background should be increased
- More focus should be given for enhancement of English Communication Skills.
- More bridge course to be added
- More field based courses should be added in the Curriculum to develop skills/entrepreneurship among students
- Latest Standards & Reference Books should be added in LRC
- Utilization of Lab & Library resources should be increased
- Replacement of Pentium IV PCs and CRT Monitors
- Innovation in Lab activities should be enhanced and University be made into IT Hub
- Financial support to students in participation of Workshop and Conferences
- University Development Fee should be decreased gradually
